



Merrick County Board Minutes



January 14, 2020

The Merrick County Board of Supervisors met Tuesday, January 14, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, Central City, NE, with Kreachbaum, Weller, Kucera, Dexter, Yrkoski, Placke, and Wiegert present. County Attorney Lynelle Homolka was also present.

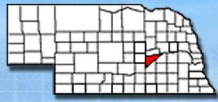
