

# Merrick County Board Minutes



June 14, 2022

The Merrick County Board of Supervisors met Tuesday, June at 9:10 a.m. in the Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, Central City, NE. Present: Kucera, Kreachbaum, Yrkoski, Dexter, Weller, and Wiegert. Absent: Placke County Attorney Shotkoski and County Clerk Strobel were also present.

Notice of the meeting was given thereof by publications in the Republican Nonpareil and The Palmer Journal and the Merrick County Website. Proof of publication is filed in the Clerk's Office. Copies of the agenda were given to each Supervisor and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

Chairman Wiegert declared the meeting was preceded by publicized notice and having acknowledged and identified the location of the posting of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act, called the meeting to order and in open session at 9:10 a.m. Moved Kreachbaum, second Dexter to convene as Board of Supervisors at 9:10 a.m. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Agenda: Moved Dexter, second Yrkoski to approve the agenda as presented. Roll Call: All Ayes

Minutes: Moved Kucera, second Weller to approve the minutes of May 24, 2022 and May 31, 2022 as published. May 24, 2022 Minutes-Roll Call: Ayes: Yrkoski, Kreachbaum, Kucera, Weller and Wiegert, Abstain: Dexter. Motion Carried. May 31, 2022 Roll Call: All Ayes.

Meeting Reports: Yrkoski, Kreachbaum, Kucera, Wiegert, Dexter and Weller attended the NACO County Board workshop in Kearney June 8th and 9th. Kreachbaum-Emergency Management Committee Meeting evening of June 14. Dexter-May 23rd conference call with SCEDD, June 3rd Merrick County Economic Development, June 6-5 Nines assessment meeting. Dexter, Weller and Kucera met with Zelle May 26th, Wiegert-June 2nd, Midland Area on Aging in Hastings.

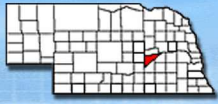
Officials Reports: Sheriff Westman reported the Sheriff's office has been very busy, has also been working on budget items and had an excellent candidate for the open deputy's position. Steve Melvin, Extension Educator joined the meeting via phone. Kucera wanted Melvin to address the Board to report on the water testing results in regards to Randy Zmek's request. Melvin stated that Nebraska Department of Environment & Energy to go out and test six samples. On April 11th, the samples were collected by Olsson & Associates, an engineering firm based out of Kearney, along with Melvin, Zmek met up with them for a short time. Each owner was also contacted. The collected samples were checked for general explosives test which had several different possibilities of explosives. They also checked for Arsenic, Iron, Manganese, Uranium, Perchlorate and Nitrate Nitrogen. None of the samples came back with any results of explosives. All information gathered is available to the public and is available through the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy. Every letter sent out is accessible with the results as well as the field notes taken by the engineer. Three samples were taken around Archer, the other three were towards Grand Island and ended up north of the airport, these were the sites recommended to test. Within the six samples that were taken there was no sign of RDX.

No exceptions 179 GP/231 HP. Murphy Tractor presented two bids-State bid total price w/o trade in \$317,991.00. 770 GP with 255 HP with a delivery date December 2022-January 2023, minimum 5 year/5000 hrs. with 100% parts/labor or 7 years/7000 comp. No exceptions. Next bid from Murphy on a 670 GP-235 HP, total bid price \$299,990.00; delivery date December 2022-January 2023. 5 years/5000 hrs.
