Officials Report: Treasurer Gilg updated the status on the highway and surveyor accounts receivable past due accounts including townships. Gilg reached out to the Attorney General regarding the Opioid settlement money. The money may be utilized for Region III through the Interlocal Agreement with a letter stating the funds need to be used for Opioid remediation according to Schedule E. Vieregg Township past due balances was a result of miscommunication over time and changing of officers over the years. Vieregg Township will make a payment and all payments directed to them will be deposited into the road account until the account is caught up. Highway Superintendent Kunze addressed changing the method of tracking employee hours and have the employees work the same hours. Kunze is also looking into DocuSign for employees to electronically sign their time card. For safety concerns, Kunze would also like to start incorporating different attire for the road's employees during the fall/winter months. NIRMA has a safety program which offers funds which provide reflective shirts. L Road Bridge is being engineered by McNelly Wagner. Hamilton County Highway Superintendent informed Kunze there are issues with some piers on the Bader Park Bridge, an agreement has been signed with an engineer. The cost would be split between the two counties, the estimate is \$58,000.00 of which \$29,000.00 would be Merrick County's which does not include the repair costs. Kunze also informed the board NIRMA has traffic counters to lend out when needed. Safety training will be a priority, NIRMA provides and L-Tap will be providing barricade and flagger training which there is no cost. GPS tracking is active on all maintainers and being monitored. Tire Amnesty Day was Saturday, September 9th in which 5500 tires were brought in. Bridge inspection classes will be held fall of 2024 and Superintendent Licensure is May 2024. Clerk Strobel informed the board the Flu Shot Clinic will be held October 16th from 9 until 4:00 p.m. Twin River School Bond Special Election end today at 5:00 p.m. the clerk will be traveling to Nance County in order to deliver the Merrick County ballots. The clerk's office will be receiving the referendum petitions for the Private Education Tax Credits to begin processing.
