The Merrick County Board of Equalization met Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, Central City, NE, with Kucera, Dexter, Kreachbaum, Weller, Yrkoski, Placke, and Wiegert present. Deputy County Attorney Kunz was also present.
